community and station on Seattle-Everett Interurban, located 12 stops south of EVERETT; Census Designated Place 2000; 5 miles east of EDMONDS; S15; T27N; R4E; post office established 1920, discontinued 1963, replaced by ALDERWOOD MANOR STATION; 22K acres of 5-acre farm plots; Puget Mill Co; townsite plat; populated place – GNIS (AMHPk, cdp2000, mapdlorm, pmarkWA, thommap, whithis, kroll52, GNIS)

precinct 2000, voting at LYNNWOOD , precinct 2011 (pre2000, pre2011)

ALLEN 1

.5 mile south of OSO RR station; S17; T32N; R7E; post office established 1889 in Thomas Bond homestead at Deer Creek; named ALLEN for John Allen, territorial delegate to Congress; name changed to OSO 18 Jan 1890 to avoid confusion with ALLYN in Mason Co (pmarkWA, tacpl, pnWA, wagaz01, whithis)

ARLINGTON HEIGHTS

census designated place 2000; ne of ARLINGTON; S8, 9; T31N; R6E ; populated place GNIS (llHis, cdp2000, mapdlorm, thommap, GNIS)

north of ARLINGTON; populated place GNIS (mapdlorm, kroll52, GNIS)

station on Seattle-Everett Interurban, 5 stops south of EVERETT; west of LOWELL; precinct 1915, precinct District 2 1926, precinct 1930; ED 31- 006, precinct 1937 Commissioner District 2; north of #526, west of I-5 (IlHisSnoCo, AMHPk, whithis, pre1937, thommap, metzmap, mapdlorm, kroll52)

BIG BURN

area between EDGECOMB and GETCHELL (IlHisSnoCo)

BIG FOUR

east of SILVERTON on Mountain Loop Hwy, S33; T30N; R10E; post office at Big Four Inn established 1922, discontinued 1934; locale GNIS (IlHisSnoCo, pmarkWA, mapdlorm, tacpl, thommap, kroll52, GNIS)

BIRMINGHAM

6 miles south of STANWOOD, S13; T31N; R3E; post office established 7 Feb 1910; renamed WARM BEACH 14 Nov 1923 (pmarkWA, tacpl, pnWA, kroll52)

city, part in Snohomish Co, part in King Co; S3; T26N; R5E; 5 miles east of north end of Lake Washington; on S and I Ry (cdp2000, pre2000, tacpl, thommap, wagaz01)

precinct 1894, precinct 1900 ED 209, precinct 1937, Commissioner District 1, T32N; R5, 6E, precinct 2000; voting at ARLINGTON; precinct 2011 (pre1900, pre1937, whithis, pre2000, pre2011)

white-water area of Skykomish River between INDEX and HIGH BRIDGE (IlHistSnoCo)

grange established 1910, mailing address SNOHOMISH RD 3 (granges)

locality between LYNNWOOD and EVERETT, Evergreen Way and Rte 526; populated place GNIS (thommap, metzmap, GNIS)

CASSIDY

train stop for West Coast Railway construction contractors Thomas Earle and James McLeod in MALTBY area (LOSHO)

WOODS TRAIL

precinct 2000; voting at LYNNWOOD (pre2000)

WOODSHIRE

precinct 2000; voting at SNOHOMISH; precinct 2011 (pre2000, pre2011)

WOODWAY

city south of EDMONDS; original name Woodway Park when founded by Dave Whitcomb, Sr, who bought property in 1912; incorporated 1958; precinct 2000, census designated place 2000; populated place GNIS (IIHisSnoCo, cdp2000, mapdlorm, pre2000, google, thommap, GNIS)

WYATT PARK

SnoCo Regional Park on Lake Stevens; formerly DAVIES BEACH; precinct 2000; voting at LAKE STEVENS (SCoParks; pre2000)

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YEW

5 miles southwest of MALTBY; S24; T27N; R5E; post office established 1889, name changed to MALTBY 1893; town platted 31 Jan 1891; station on S and I Railway; precinct 1892 (llHisSnoCo, pmarkWA, tacpl, wagaz01, whithis)

YORK (1)

7 miles north of BOTHELL; Sec 9; T27N; R5E; post office located in York's homestead, established 1901, discontinued 1903, with mail to BOTHELL (pmarkWA)

YORK (2)

precinct 2000, voting at EVERETT; precinct 2011 (pre2000, pre2011)

YOUNG

post office established 30 June 1892, discontinued 11 June 1895, "no papers" (pmarkWA)

YOUNGS CREEK

8 miles south of SULTAN (GNIS)

YOUTH-ON-AGE

locale GNIS 480412N – 1213839W, trail near VERLOT, named for native plant common to area (GNIS)
